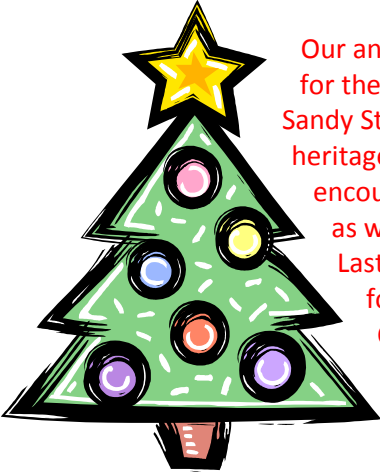
Walter Stanford

Falling Rivers Gallery is responsible for the cost of all necessary supplies. We currently have a good supply of gesso, 16x20 canvases, acrylic paints, and brushes. We also have a reasonable supply of alcohol inks, yupo paper (5x7) and gloves. However if your idea uses different supplies, keep in mind that the budget is \$5/participant.

Art of the Vine is a monthly event held on the third Thursday of each month (January to October) from 5:30 to 7:30. The goal is to have fun with the art project. It is targeted to participants who may never have taken art workshops and may not have any art experience. Your project should keep that in mind. We pay \$100 to the host of each event and only cancel if no registers.

This event is a very important component of the Gallery and we want to provide high quality projects that promote individual expression while ensuring the participant feels satisfied with the result.
