- **Malia Bryngelson's** pastel won Best in Show at the Mooresville Fall Artfest 2015 Show.



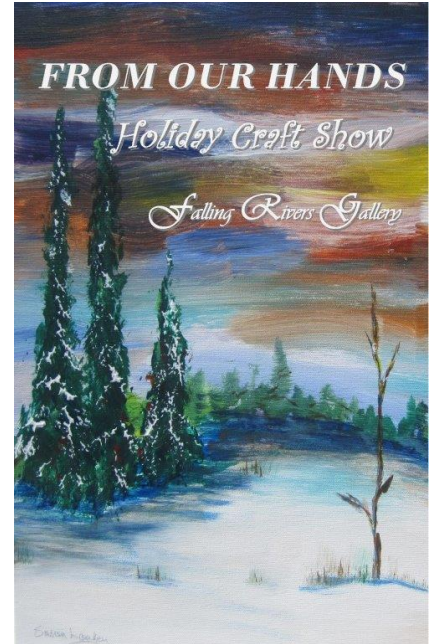
