## Member's Show October 7 through November 6

The Stanly Arts Guild will hold its Annual Member's Show October 7 through November 6 at Falling Rivers Gallery. All members who enter will be eligible for ribbon and cash awards and new memberships are welcomed at the front desk.

The judge for the show will be well-known Charlotte artist and instructor Bruce Chandler. She enjoys the process of painting different styles and mediums. Bruce may paint her subject photo realistically or the style may be in between or humorous. It might be a very different subject or a part of a series. One thing is for certain; it will tell a story.

She credits her many years of teaching for enabling her ability to dart back and forth to tell her story best. Bruce says that the elements that guide her judging process begin with concept and passion. Next is composition followed by the elements of design. She adds that technique is important and lastly, when faced with pieces of equal quality, she looks for the personality of the artist in the work of art itself.

The show is expected to bring out the best work from the Stanly Arts Guild's creative and diverse artists. Categories will include paintings, photography, sculpture, wood, metal, pottery and other approved dimensional pieces.

Reservation in South Dakota. The owner of the collection, Ernest L. Stoffel, Jr., made seven trips to South Dakota from 2009 – 2012. On each trip he stayed from two to four weeks. While there, he worked with the tribal council to provide water for drinking and cooking and to winterize homes by replacing windows, siding, and roofs. At the end of each visit, members of the tribe presented him with hand-made items, which you see in this collection.

Mr. Stoffel became a permanent member of our Stanly County community in August 2013.
